Who can access Wungening Alcohol and Other Drugs Services?

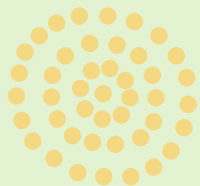
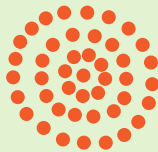
- Anyone experiencing problems with alcohol and/or other drug use.
- Anyone who is worried about the alcohol or drug use of somebody you care about.

Do I have to pay for Wungening Services?

No – all our services are provided at no cost to you.

How can I get support from Wungening?

- You could be referred by another agency whom you already have a relationship with.
- You could go to any Wungening location and self-refer at reception.
- You could phone any Wungening location to make an appointment.



What type of support is available to me?

Wungening's alcohol and other drug support programs include:

- Counselling and education for individuals and families.
- Diversion programs for those referred by the courts or police.
- Assertive outreach to people experiencing difficulties accessing services.
- Solid Ground day program – a supportive and culturally safe group that meets every morning Monday to Friday at Wungening's East Perth, Midland and Armadale locations.



What are my rights when using Wungening AOD services?

- You have the right to receive a free service.
- You have the right to be treated with respect and dignity at all times.
- You have the right to receive a professional and confidential service at all times.
- You have the right to submit a formal complaint should you not be happy with any parts of Wungening services and to have your complaint investigated and the findings of your complaint fed back to you. The complaints process is explained to every client entering Wungening services.

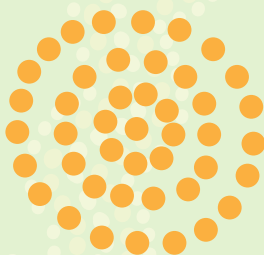
